The fair serves as a platform to provide employers a chance to source for employees as well as to create awareness of jobs.

The college strengthens its links with business and industry to provide students and graduates with chances to boost their career prospects.

Students and graduates can connect with employers through information sessions, on-campus interviews and on-campus recruiting events, which offer opportunities for internships or employment in the corporate sector and industries.

Minister of Human Resources Datuk Seri Dr Fong Chan Onn launched the last fair in November.

Seventy-one companies including banking and finance, business and management consultancies, tourism, real estate, software and IT, manufacturing and engineering took part.

Participants included companies from Malaysia and Singapore as well as multi-national companies such as AC Nielsen, KPMG, Genting Resort World, Megasteel, Panasonic, CIMB, British American Tobacco, Maxis, HSBC and Shimano.

During the week-long event, 24 sessions of career talks were delivered by speakers from industries and professional bodies covering topics such as job opportunities in various industries, business etiquette, resume writing, grooming for corporate world and preparation for attending interviews.

At the same event, the college also launched the Student Job Placement Ser-

vices). This is an online service that provides students and graduates with access to the database of potential employers for recruitment and internship purposes.

The November fair has attracted more than 6,000 students and celebrated the largest number of participating companies since it started five years ago.
